

Standard Community Garden and Grounds Chores

Barrett House Shelter has a community garden along with a large yard, front parking area and a side alley that need to be maintained.

We have opportunities for ad-hoc gardening and also for regular weekly, bi-weekly or monthly garden sustaining and maintenance.

Community Garden:

- Weed garden beds
- Check for insects and remove as needed
- Bring compost out to composters, water and turn



- Stake vegetables as needed
- Water if needed
- Cover and uncover as needed in cold months
- Other seasonal tasks such as bed turning, seeding, harvesting, fertilizing, etc.

Grounds (includes front, back and alley areas):

- Prune shrubs and trees
- Sweep patios and walkways
- Weed rock, wood chip and gravel areas
- Weed flower area around fountain
- Fill fountain with water
- Water flower area around fountain as needed
- Cut back any elm trees coming up
- Rake and weed kids sand area
- Blow seeds/leaves out of rocks and wood chips
- Straighten up shed as needed
- Anything else that looks like it needs to be done
